| 1 | .310.01.c. Medication Distribution System. | The facility's medication refrigerator temperatures were not monitored and documented daily for at least the last few months, and the refrigerator contained insulin. The administrator stated the facility had not been documenting the temperatures. |
| 2 | .310.04.e. Psychotropic or Behavior Modifying Medication. | Four of four residents who were taking psychotropic medications for at least six months did not have six month psychotropic medication reviews completed. For example, Resident #1 was taking divalproex sodium, lorazepam, quetiapine, and sertraline. Resident #2 was taking lorazepam, sertraline, trazodone, and haloperidol. Resident #4 was taking divalproex sodium, lorazepam, and sertraline. The facility nurse and administrator stated they had completed the reviews in the past but had not been completing the reviews for about a year. |
| 3 | .630.04. Traumatic Brain Injury. | Five of five staff members, whose personnel files were reviewed, did not have specialized training for traumatic brain injury. The facility had one resident who was diagnosed with a traumatic brain injury. The administrator confirmed the facility admitted a resident with the diagnosis of traumatic brain injury and the staff members had not received the specialized |

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
