FARMINGTON CONGREGATE ASSOCIATES, an ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM, is not in substantial compliance with Part of 10-144, Chapter 113, Regulations Governing the Licensing and Functioning of Assisted Housing Programs: ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM. The following requirements were not met:

**7 MEDICATIONS AND TREATMENTS**

**7.3.2** Medications administered by the assisted living program shall be kept in their original containers in a locked storage cabinet. The cabinet shall be equipped with separate cubicles, plainly labeled, or with other physical separation for the storage of each consumer’s medications. It shall be locked when not in use and the key carried by the person on duty in charge of medication administration. [Class III]

This has not been met as evidenced by:

Based on observation and interview the facility failed to keep consumer medications in separate cubicles.

Finding:

On 3/21/2024 an inspection of the facility medication cabinet was completed. Consumer #2, Consumer #3 and Consumer #4’s eye drops were not stored in separate cubicles.

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This finding was confirmed with the Tenant Service Director at the time of the survey and at the exit interview on 3/21/2024.

**14 PHYSICAL PLANT AND SANITATION**

**14.4 Water temperature.** The hot water temperature for consumer use must be between 105°F. and 120°F. and in adequate supply.

This has not been met as evidenced by:

Based on observation and an interview, the facility failed to ensure water temperatures in consumer areas did not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Finding:

The hot water temperature was tested on 3/21/2024 at approximately 11:00 a.m. and exceeded 120 degrees Fahrenheit. The hot water temperature in room 101 was 125 degrees Fahrenheit in the kitchen and 123.1 degrees Fahrenheit in the bathroom. The hot water temperature in room 201 was 125.8 degrees Fahrenheit in the kitchen and 124.5 degrees Fahrenheit in the bathroom.

The Tenant Service Director contacted maintenance to have the temperature lowered.

This finding was confirmed with the Tenant Service Director at the time of the survey and at the exit interview on 3/21/2024.
