185a - Implement Storage Procedures

1. Requirements

2600.

185.a. The home shall develop and implement procedures for the safe storage, access, security, distribution and use of medications and medical equipment by trained staff persons.

Description of Violation

Resident #1 has an order to have their blood glucose tested 3 times a day. On 9/5/25 at 12:00p.m. the resident's glucometer indicated a reading of 149; 164 was incorrectly recorded on the medication administration record.

Plan of Correction

Accept (█ - 09/29/2025)

Action: The Staff Member who documented incorrectly is a part-time med tech. On █ next scheduled shift 9/19/25, education was provided by the Administrator on how to document blood sugars accurately from what the reading was on the glucometer into the electronic medication administration record. The incorrect blood sugar was corrected on the electronic medication administration record on 9/12/25 by Med Tech, and the correct number was recorded with accuracy from the blood glucose monitor.

Training: On 9/17/25, at 2:00pm, the Administrator held an all-staff meeting and was educated on the proper documentation of blood glucose results in accordance with Regulation 2600.185A. All documentation will be kept in accordance with regulation 2600.65i.

Ongoing: Starting 9/14/2025, the Resident Care Coordinator and/or Director of Nursing will complete glucometer audits weekly for 3 months and then monthly thereafter. These audits will be monitored by the administrator on an ongoing basis and be reviewed at our Quality Assurance meeting beginning October 28,2025. All documentation will be kept in accordance with regulation 2600.65i.

187d - Follow Prescriber's Orders

2. Requirements

2600.

187.d. The home shall follow the directions of the prescriber.

Description of Violation

Resident #2 has an order for Metoprolol Tartrate 25mg, one tablet twice daily, hold for systolic blood pressure less than 100 or heart rate less than 50. The home did not measure resident #1's heart rate prior to administering the medication from 9/1/25 through 9/10/25.

Plan of Correction

Accept (█ - 09/29/2025)

Action: On 9/10/2025, Resident #2's Electronic Medication Administration Record was updated to include the pulse documentation. On 9/27/2025 an initial audit of all Electronic Medication Administration Records was started to ensure that all required parameters ordered by the physician are being appropriately documented. This audit will be completed by the Director of Nursing and/or the Administrator. This audit will be completed by 10/3/2025.

Training: On 9/17/25, the Administrator held an all-staff meeting that included training on documenting parameters and reading orders correctly in accordance with Regulation 2600.187d. The Director of Nursing and Resident Care Coordinator, who approve orders, will be educated on Regulation 2600.187d on 10/2/25 by the Administrator. All documentation will be kept in accordance with 2600.65i.

Ongoing: Beginning 10/3/2025, the Director of Nursing and/or Resident Care Coordination will conduct a weekly audit of medication parameters completed for 3 months, then monthly for one year. These audits will be monitored by the Administrator for compliance and to ensure that all documentation is complete to follow prescribers' orders.
