144c1 - Smoking Area Guidelines

1. Requirements

2600.

144.c. A home that permits smoking inside or outside of the home shall develop and implement written fire safety policy and procedures that include the following:

- 1. Proper safeguards inside and outside of the home to prevent fire hazards involved in smoking, including providing fireproof receptacles and ashtrays, direct outside ventilation, no interior ventilation from the smoking room through other parts of the home, extinguishing procedures, fire resistant furniture both inside and outside the home and fire extinguishers in the smoking rooms.

Description of Violation

At approximately 9:55 a.m., outside the rear exit door that is located near room [REDACTED] Two cigarette butts were observed lying in the mulch.

Immediately following the inspection the maintenance director cleaned up the cigarettes butts. On July 9 Executive Director did a counseling with the Maintenance director on regulation 2600.144.c. On July 9 the Executive Director sent letters out to residents and families, staff and vendors on our smoking policy and were the designated smoking area is. July 23 No smoking signs were posted around the building. The Maintenance Director will do a daily walk to ensure that there are no cigarettes butts on ground. The Maintenance Director and Executive Director will be responsible for ongoing compliance
