1. Requirements

2600.

231.b. Regulation Cited: 2600. 231.b. A resident shall have a medical evaluation by a physician, physician’s assistant, or certified registered nurse practitioner, documented on a form provided by the Department, within 60 days prior to admission. Documentation shall include the resident’s diagnosis of Alzheimer’s disease or other dementia and the need for the resident to be served in a secured dementia care unit.

Description of Violation: Resident #1 was admitted to the Secure Dementia Care Unit (SDCU) on [REDACTED]; however, the resident’s medical evaluation was completed on [REDACTED]

Action plan to fix: Resident # 1 was admitted to the Secure Dementia Unit from another outside community location. The resident was brought into the Secure Dementia Unit and seen by [REDACTED] new Primary Care Physician in the facility and [REDACTED] medical evaluation was completed 4 days after admission. Moving forward, any resident admitted into the 15 bed Secure Dementia Unit will have a medical evaluation by a physician, physician’s assistant, or certified registered nurse practitioner, documented on a form provided by the Department, within 60 days prior to admission. The resident will not be accepted into the Secure Dementia Unit until seen by a provider within 60 days prior to admission.

Education: Education of regulation to Admissions Coordinator, this PCHA, RN Coordinator and Designee responsible for admitting residents into the Personal Care Center and Secure Dementia Unit.

Maintaining Compliance: The Personal Care Administrator or RN Coordinator will be responsible for reviewing admission paperwork, including DHS required forms for the Secure Dementia Unit prior to admission. Any resident being admitted/accepted into the Secure Dementia Unit will be seen 60 days prior to admission with a completed medical evaluation prior to admission.
