Description of Violation

Resident #1's significant change assessment, dated [REDACTED], indicated Care at Home private duty caregivers as a formal support but did not specify the care and services provided by the Care at Home caregivers beginning [REDACTED] to include transferring in/out of bed/chair, bowel and bladder management, personal hygiene, and supervision when leaving the facility.

Resident #1's significant change assessment, dated [REDACTED], did not indicate the degree of need for personal care services related to turning and positioning in bed/chair, that section was left incomplete.

Plan of Correction**Accept [REDACTED] - 06/03/2024)**

In response to the violation on 05/21/2024 by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Human Service Licensing, immediate action was taken on 05/21/2024 by the Assistant Personal Care Home Administrator and Assistant Personal Care Home Administrator corrected immediately by completing an addendum on Support Plan.

To enhance the currently compliant operations, on 06/03/2024 the Administrator/designee will will complete audits on all support plans for Brookwood. audits will include 5 residents weekly for 1 month then quarterly, with a completion date of 05/19/2025.

Effective 06/03/2024 the Administrator/designee will perform weekly audits through 05/19/2025 to maintain ongoing compliance with 2600.225.c.

Administrator/designee will complete weekly audits for 5 residents for 1 month then quarterly ensuring each resident has additional assessments added to support plan for any external services requested for residents care, including toileting, transferring, etc. at the request of the Department upon cause to believe that an update is required. Compliance monitoring activities will be implemented under the supervision of the Administrator. Any deficiencies will be corrected immediately, and findings will be documented and submitted to the Designee for further review and continuous improvement.
